



## **EXAMPLES OF MOST FREQUENT INFRACTIONS**

### **SUFFERING AND DISTRESS**

Persons should not be shown in emergency situations especially while suffering or in distress.

Such as the following:

- In a news report a woman is being interviewed for the loss of her husband. She reached the point to where she cannot speak anymore and starts to break down. The cameraman keeps the camera on her as she continues to cry and faint.
- Footage from the scene of an accident where the persons injured are focused on, where blood and injuries can be seen.
- Close up of open wounds and/or dead bodies, or those who are injured.

### **LACK OF DISCLAIMERS AND ADVISORIES**

- Alcohol Advertisements should carry disclaimers before, during and/or after stating "please drink responsibly. Must be 18 years and older.
- Graphic scenes or images from programmes should carry a disclaimer warning audience of incoming image/scene.
- Movies should have the ratings displayed on the screen. E.g. PG-13, Rated-R, Rated-G.

### **PROTECTION OF PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN**

The following should never be broadcast during Prime time hours from 06:00hrs – 22:00hrs:

- Indecent, vulgar language
- Nudity
- Sexual content or language e.g. words like pussy and cocky
- Alcohol promotion when children's programmes are being aired.
- Scenes of dangerous self-harming behavior without an advisory or disclaimer
- Violence

***The identity of a minor should never be revealed through their name or any information that may lead to their identity, unless consent given by the parent or guardian.***
